NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entry fees: \$28.00 (includes AKC recording* and service fee) for the first entry of a dog in each Obedience/Rally Trial, \$24.00 for the second entry of the same dog in the same Trial.

* "A RECORDING FEE of 50¢ and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee are required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. This recording fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only." (AKC Rule, Chapter 15, Section 2).

Make all checks and money orders payable to: Salisbury MD Kennel Club Inc. (SMKC, Inc.). Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

Mail all entries for both trials with fees to: Jeannine Dennis, 6767 Powellville Rd, Willards MD 21874.

Entries without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable..

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded for bitches in season, or if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Post Dated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee o the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a **cash only** basis.

Errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. **All dogs present** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. No dog may be permanently removed from the show before it is judged except by consent of the Trial Secretary upon a veterinarian's recommendation of removal.

Please Note: January 1, 2009 Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1 Section 3, Jump Heights required with entry. Include Jump Height on entry form with class. Entries without Jump Height will be judged at the end of the class

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows/Registration and Discipline" and, if this entry is for a rally trial, the "Rally Regulations," have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under "AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines." I (we) agree that the club holding this show or rally trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause that the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or rally trial, and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury that may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or rally trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

INSTRUCTIONS

1 1 .. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2 2 .. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3 3 .. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4 4 .. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
