DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC Pal (ILP) numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance.

Rosettes for 1st through 4th place in each jump height in each class. **Qualifying ribbons** for all exhibitors attaining a Qualifying Score. MACH bars will be given to any dog earning a MACH at the trial. PAX bars will be given to any dog earning a PAX at the trial.

MOVE UPS:

Request for Move-ups for Friday must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than **6PM on Monday, August 17, 2009** . **Saturday and Sunday** move ups must be recorded in the *Move Up Book* for the **Trial Secretary within half an hour after the last run of the day Friday or Saturday.**

- ❑ Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run.

CONFIRMATION:

- ❑ **A Preliminary confirmation will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections immediately.**
- ❑ **Final confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent to the email address on the AKC Entry Form after the closing date. Anyone wanting a mailed copy MUST include a self addressed stamped envelope with their entry.**

ENTRY FEE \$24.00 for the first entry of a dog; \$13.00 for second entry and \$13 for third entry of the same dog per day. (Includes a per day per dog \$3.00 AKC recording fee) Envelopes/transactions cannot have entries for more than the (10) dog maximum. **No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours.**

REFUNDS Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the Show Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Refunds will be given (less AKC fees) for bitches in season or dogs injured after closing. Written notification, including a **Veterinarian's letter**, must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than **6PM Wednesday, August 26, 2009.**

Entry fee will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. The club may cancel the trial in extreme weather conditions.
