DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance.

Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. For copies of the Regulations write AKC, 5580 Centerview Dr., Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606-3390, call 919-233-3785, or go to www.akc.org

Height Divisions: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. At the handler’s option, dogs may be entered in a higher jump height class, in regular classes only.

RIBBONS

Rosettes for 1st through 4th place in each jump height in each class. **Qualifying ribbons** for all exhibitors attaining a Qualifying Score. MACH bars will be given to any dog earning a MACH at the trial. PAX bars will be given to any dog earning a PAX at the trial.

MOVE UPS:

Request for Move-ups for Saturday must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than **6 PM on Monday, June 2, 2008**. **Sunday** move ups must be recorded in the Move Up Book for the **Trial Secretary within half an hour after the last run of the day on Saturday.**

BUILDING:

- Please pick up after your dogs so we can continue to use this wonderful facility. Any Exhibitor caught not cleaning up after their dog will be asked to leave the trial grounds. No refunds will be given if this occurs.
- Parking in the rear of the building only.
- Dogs will not be permitted in certain areas of the building. These areas will be clearly marked.

TRIAL SPECIFICS:

- ❑ Building is available from 5:30pm until 10pm on Friday evening for set up.
- ❑ Doors will open at 6:30am each day.
- ❑ Crating space is limited. Please be conservative. EX Pens allowed for multiple dog crating only.
- ❑ No Outside Food or Drinks. A Café is available on the premises with good selection of food and drinks at reasonable prices.
- ❑ Puppies under 6 months are strictly prohibited
- ❑ All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or in the designated warm-up areas.
- ❑ Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog prior to the start of the class. Course familiarization will NOT be offered.
- ❑ Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run.
- ❑ All equipment shall meet the specifications in the current edition of "Regulations for Agility Trials". Electronic Timers will be used.
- ❑ A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors.
- ❑ Exhibitors are responsible for double-checking the accuracy of their entry form.
- ❑ Armbands will not be mailed. Please check in for your armbands.

CONFIRMATION:

- ❑ **A Preliminary confirmation will be sent to the email address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections immediately.**
- ❑ **Final confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent to the email address on the AKC Entry Form after the closing date. Anyone requesting a mailed copy MUST include a self addressed stamped envelope with their entry.**

ENTRY FEE \$24.00 for the first entry of a dog; \$13.00 for second entry and \$13 for third entry of the same dog per day. (Includes a per day per dog \$3.00 AKC recording fee) Envelopes/transactions cannot have entries for more than the (10) dog maximum. **No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours.**

REFUNDS Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the Show Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Refunds will be given (less an administration fee) for bitches in season or dogs injured after closing. Written notification, including a **Veterinarian's letter**, must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than **6PM Wednesday June 11, 2008**

Entry fee will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. The club may cancel the trial in extreme weather conditions.
